

**ELECTRONICS ENGINEERING INSTRUCTORS SCHOLARSHIP-LINN STATE TECHNICAL COLLEGE  
SPONSORED BY THE ELECTRONICS ENGINEERING TECHNOLOGY INSTRUCTORS  
SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES**

### GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Sponsored by the Linn State Technical College Electronics Engineering Technology Instructors, one \$500 scholarship is awarded each year to a full-time college student pursuing an Associate of Applied Science Degree in Electronics Engineering Technology (EET).

### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- A. Applicant should be enrolled as a full-time (12 hours minimum per semester), first or second year student.
- B. Applicant should enroll the fall semester as a full-time student.
- C. Applicant should be a citizen of the United States.
- D. Applicant should be in good academic standing and meet academic program requirements.

### SELECTION AND AWARD OF SCHOLARSHIP

- A. Selection Criteria. To be considered, applicants must forward a complete application packet by the scholarship application deadline. The criteria used to evaluate applications for award will be based equally upon the following:
  - Financial need.
  - Academic achievement.
  - Civic involvement through school and community.
  - Leadership demonstrated through extracurricular involvement.
- B. Selection Priority. Final selection will be determined by the EET faculty. In the event a student is unable to fulfill the requirement of full-time enrollment for the fall semester in the year the scholarship is awarded, the scholarship will be transferred to the next available alternate.
- C. Scholarship Award. The scholarship provides \$500. The scholarship award will be credited to the recipient's account at Linn State Technical College. The scholarship will apply toward the cost of tuition, fees, books, tools, and/or other costs associated with a student's education.
- D. In addition to fulfilling scholarship criteria, consideration is based on availability of funds.

### APPLICATION PACKET

Deadline for application to assure consideration for the upcoming academic year is **February 15**. Please submit the following to be considered:

- Linn State Technical College Admissions Application.
- High school transcript or official GED score report.
- ACT scores to Linn State Technical College (LSTC ACT Code: 5105), or take the COMPASS Test at the LSTC main campus.
- Complete the online Scholarship Application (including personal goal statement and two character references) at [www.linnstate.edu/admissions/scholarships/apply.php](http://www.linnstate.edu/admissions/scholarships/apply.php).

## EXPECTATIONS OF SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT

- A. Upon accepting the scholarship, the student agrees to remain enrolled on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 college credit hours), attend classes regularly, model appropriate behavior and maintain satisfactory academic standing.
- B. In the event the student initially awarded the scholarship is unable to fulfill the requirement of full-time enrollment for the fall semester, the scholarship will be awarded to the next available selection.
- C. Release of Information. In submitting the application, the applicant grants authority for release of information contained in the application packet and to contact character references to Linn State Technical College, the Foundation for Linn State Technical College and the scholarship sponsor. This includes the right to promote and publicize the scholarship and recipient(s). If selected, the recipient agrees to participate in ceremonies hosted to honor annual scholarship winners.
- D. If selected, the recipient agrees to send a thank you letter to the scholarship sponsor. Thank you letters must be submitted to the Foundation Office at Linn State Technical College no later than one month after award is announced.
