

**MISSOURI RIVER AUTO PARTS – NAPA AUTO PARTS –
LINN STATE TECHNICAL COLLEGE
SCHOLARSHIP GUIDLINES**

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Missouri River Auto Parts awards two (2) \$500 scholarships annually to individuals pursuing an associate of applied science degree or certificate at Linn State Technical College in one of the following programs: Automotive Collision Technology, Automotive Technology, Aviation Maintenance, Commercial Turf & Grounds Management, Construction & Civil Technology, Electric Power Generation, Electrical Distribution Systems, Electronics Engineering Technology, Heating, Ventilation & Air Conditioning, Heavy Equipment Operations, Heavy Equipment Technology, Heavy Equipment Technology Caterpillar Dealer Service Technician Option, Industrial Electricity, Machine Tool Technology, Medium/Heavy Truck Technology, or Powersports Technology. In addition to fulfilling scholarship criteria, consideration is based on availability of funds.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- A. Applicant should be a high school graduate with a 2.5 GPA or better on a 4.0 scale, or GED with 550 minimum score.
- B. Applicant should be enrolled as a first year full-time student (12 semester credit hours minimum) at Linn State Technical College for the fall semester.
- C. Students with financial need will receive priority consideration. Students should complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

SELECTION AND AWARD OF SCHOLARSHIP

- A. Selection criteria. To be considered, applicants must forward a complete application packet by the scholarship application deadline. The criteria used to evaluate applications for award will be based upon the following:
 - Financial need.
 - Civic involvement through school and community.
 - Leadership demonstrated through extracurricular involvement.
 - Academic achievement and aptitude toward technical fields as demonstrated through achievement in technically related courses, vocational student organization involvement and skill competition results.
 - Ability to communicate clearly defined personal goals through personal goal statement (on application).
- B. Selection Priority. This is a one time, annual scholarship awarded to full-time students attending Linn State Technical College. Priority of selection will go to first-time college freshmen, then to transfer students. In addition to the designated recipients, an alternate will also be selected. In the event a student is unable to fulfill the requirement of full-time enrollment for the fall semester in the year the scholarship is awarded, the scholarship will be given to the next available alternate.
- C. Scholarship Award. The scholarship provides \$500, which is applied to recipient's account at Linn State Technical College in the fall semester upon the student's verified enrollment. The scholarship can be used for the cost of tuition, fees, books, tools, and/or other costs associated with a student's education.

APPLICATION PACKET

Deadline for application to assure consideration for the upcoming academic year is **October 15**. Please submit the following to be considered:

- Linn State Technical College Admissions Application.
- High school transcript or official GED score report.
- ACT scores to Linn State Technical College (LSTC ACT Code: 5105), or take the COMPASS Test at the LSTC main campus.
- Complete the online Scholarship Application (including personal goal statement and two character references) at www.linnstate.edu/admissions/scholarships/apply.php.

EXPECTATIONS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT

- A. Upon accepting the scholarship, the student agrees to remain enrolled on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 college credit hours), attend classes regularly, model appropriate behavior and maintain satisfactory academic standing.
- B. In the event the student initially awarded the scholarship is unable to fulfill the requirement of full-time enrollment for the fall semester, the scholarship will be awarded to the next available alternate.
- C. Release of Information. In submitting the application, the applicant grants authority for release of information contained in the application packet and to contact character references to Linn State Technical College, the Foundation for Linn State Technical College and the scholarship sponsor. This includes the right to promote and publicize the scholarship and recipient(s).
- D. If selected, the recipient agrees to participate in ceremonies hosted to honor scholarship winners and the recipient must send a thank-you letter to the scholarship sponsor. Thank you letters must be submitted to the Foundation Office at Linn State Technical College no later than one month after award is announced.
