

WIDEL INC. - LINN STATE TECHNICAL COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Widel, Inc., Blackwater, MO, awards one \$2,000 scholarship incrementally over four semesters to an individual pursuing an Associate of Applied Science Degree in Construction & Civil Technology at Linn State Technical College. In addition to fulfilling scholarship criteria, consideration is based upon availability of funds.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- A. Applicant should be a graduate of Boonville High School or Pilot Grove High School.
- B. Applicant should be enrolled as a first year full-time (12 hours minimum per semester) student.
- C. Applicant should be a resident of Missouri.
- D. Applicant should be a student in good academic standing with a minimum 2.5 college or high school cumulative GPA or GED with 260 minimum score.

SELECTION AND AWARD OF SCHOLARSHIP

- A. Selection Criteria. To be considered, applicants must forward a complete application packet by the scholarship application deadline. Only scholarship finalists will be contacted for an interview by Widel, Inc. representatives. The criteria used to evaluate applications for award will be based upon the following:
 - a. Academic achievement.
 - b. Civic involvement through school and community.
 - c. Leadership demonstrated through extracurricular involvement.
 - d. Aptitude toward technical fields as demonstrated through academic achievement in technically related courses, vocational student organization involvement and skill competition results.
 - e. Ability to communicate clearly defined personal goals through written essay.
 - f. Preference will be given to those demonstrating financial need.
- B. Priority for Selection. This is an annual scholarship. In the event a student is unable to fulfill the requirement of full-time enrollment for the fall semester in the year the scholarship is awarded, the next available alternate will be considered. Priority of selection is based upon an individual's general aptitude and personal traits that are viewed conducive to success in the construction field.
- C. Scholarship Award. The scholarship provides \$500, which is applied directly to the recipient's account at Linn State Technical College in the fall semester upon the student's verified enrollment. The scholarship may be used for tuition, fees, books, tools, and/or other cost associated with a student's education.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Deadline for application to assure consideration for the next following academic year is **June 1**. Please submit the following to be considered:

- Linn State Technical College Admissions Application.
- High school transcript, official GED score report or college transcript.
- ACT scores to Linn State Technical College (LSTC ACT Code: 5105), or take the COMPASS Test at the LSTC main campus.

- Complete the online Scholarship Application (including personal goal statement and two character references) at www.linnstate.edu/admissions/scholarships/apply.php.

EXPECTATIONS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT

- A. Upon accepting the scholarship, the student agrees to remain enrolled on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 college credit hours), have no unexcused absences, model appropriate behavior and maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA.
- B. To receive subsequent semester awards of \$500 each, recipient must maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA and have no unexcused absences. A transcript should be sent to Widel, Inc. at the conclusion of each semester to verify attendance and grades.
- C. It is expected that if available, recipient agrees to work an internship at Widel, Inc. during the summer semester.
- D. In the event the student initially awarded the scholarship is unable to fulfill the requirement of full-time enrollment for the fall semester, the next available alternate will be considered.
- E. Release of Information. In submitting the application, the applicant grants authority for release of information contained in the application packet and to contact character references to Linn State Technical College, the Foundation for Linn State Technical College and the scholarship sponsor. This includes the right to promote and publicize the scholarship and recipient(s).
- F. If selected, the recipient agrees to participate in ceremonies hosted to honor scholarship winners and the recipient must send a thank-you letter to the scholarship sponsor. Thank you letters must be submitted to the Foundation Office at Linn State Technical College no later than one month after award is announced.
